POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR AN ULTRASOUND OF THE PROSTATE AND/OR A NEEDLE BIOPSY

- 1. After the procedure, make sure that you take the antibiotic which you were given previously as directed. Avoid using aspirin for several days to avoid bleeding.
- 2. It is normal to have blood in your urine for three to four days and possibly light rectal bleeding. Some men complain of a clear to brownish discharge from the penis. You may notice blood in your semen (sperm) for up to one month afterward.
- 3. To clean out the urinary tract, drink four to six 8-ounce glasses of water daily for three or four days. If you are passing large clots, call the doctor.
- 4. It is normal to experience burning on urination for 24 hours after the biopsy.
- 5. If you have shaking chills or a fever greater than 100 degrees, please notify your doctor **immediately.**
- 6. You should not do any heavy lifting for 24 hours. No straining during a bowel movement for 48 hours.
- 7. Sexual activity should be avoided for 24 to 48 hours.

Call your doctor if......

- Your temperature rises above 100 degrees
- You have shaking chills
- You are unable to urinate when you feel that your bladder is full
- You develop a reaction to your medication such as skin rash, nausea, or vomiting
